IMPORTANT INFO

- Children's entries must state age on all labels
- Each entry **MUST** have a label attached - available on the morning of the show or from staff members.
- Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class
- All entries must conform to display requirements
- No exhibit to be removed until after 3:30pm



DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

- Flower section - Flower heads to be displayed on a black card. You can utilise, for example a tinfoil tray with a piece of cardboard glued on top so your flower head can be in water.
- Vegetable section - Carrots to be trimmed back to at least 1" of foilage. Tomatoes must be displayed in calyces. Onion tops to be tied or whipped using string. Lettuce - roots may be wrapped in plastic. Leave outer leaves on cabbages.
- Photography section - all images to be sent to events@strathdearn.org by 30th August.
- Baking & Produce - jam jars to be all full.
